Collected Information

When you register with Haydon Kerk or make a purchase we may ask for information such as your name, business, address, e-mail address, telephone number and credit card number.

Use of Information

This information may be used to customize the advertising and content you see, fulfill requests for products and services, improve our services, contact you and/or conduct research. Haydon Kerk does not, however, sell, rent or trade our customer email addresses with third parties.

Security

Haydon Kerk uses commercially accepted security measures to protect any personal information provided by you to this Website. As a result, while we strive to protect your submitted information, we cannot guarantee or warrant the security of any information you transmit to our Website, and you do so at your own risk. Cookies

“Cookies” are alphanumeric identifiers in the form of text files that are inserted and stored by your web browser on your computer’s hard drive.
